We plan to sell the operation - hopefully as a package, everything included - but there are 2 parcels that make up the present operation so who knows?? The parcel that includes the market, garden center, a couple of acres of orchard and our home is 6 acres, while the other parcel, on which James' older

brother, Stuart, and business partner's home is situated, is 22 acres and has most of the orchard. The land is in the ALR, however, so that dictates that it must continue as an agricultural operation (cidery??). It will be interesting to see how it all works out but, regardless, we're retiring. It's time to do something other than work 24/7 - although we've enjoyed it all these years - while we still enjoy good health, and to allow someone else with vision and drive write the next chapter of what happen on this land. It's been in the family for 110 years but things necessarily change with time. (I'm thinking I should write a book about gardening in the Shuswap - so watch for it in the future!)

We still have an apple crop to pick and sell this fall so our market will be open until November 10th. We will honour your loyalty cards - even if they have only a few entries - so please use them ASAP. Likewise, if you have a Gift Card, please use it ASAP, as well. If you've given a gift card to someone and they may not yet have used it, please give them a gentle reminder to use it before we close.
