PLANT OF THE WEEK:

Viburnum nudum 'Brandywine'

By now, you know that I'm a 'plant junkie' - there aren't many plants I don't like and I especially like to bring in new introductions. Some, admittedly, have been disappointments but many have become mainstays in my garden. This Plant of the Week feature is a way to introduce you to some varieties you may not be familiar with and, perhaps, it will whet your appetite enough to give the plant a try in your garden. **Featured varieties are 30% off regular price for the week they are featured.**



'Brandywine' in spring

Viburnum nudum 'Brandywine' is a Proven Winner plant that bears clusters of attractive white blooms in spring that are followed by a beautiful display of pink and blue fruit in fall. Unlike many of viburnums, 'Brandywine' doesn't need

a second variety to serve as a pollinator to produce fruit. The glossy, showy green foliage changes to wine red in fall for a truly breathtaking display of leaves and berries!



Preferring moist, well-drained soil, it's hardy to -29°C (Zone 5-6), will grow in part shade to full sun, grows to 5-6 feet tall and wide and is **DEER RESISTANT!** If you think this is a plant for you, they're 30% off until July 14, 2017.
