In spite of the rain, apple picking continues. Provided it stays dry long enough, we should have Ambrosias and more Jubilee Fuji in the market this weekend. I'm sad to say the Elstars (still my favourite) are almost gone as are the Cox's Orange Pippins but we do have some Russets and Golden Delicious in stock now. **Now is a good time to buy your winter storage apples if you have a cold room or root cellar.** Spartans and Golden Delicious are particularly good keepers often keeping for 5 months or more if kept at fairly high humidity at a temperature just above freezing.

As tedious as the doing the spring plant pre-book orders can be, it has its joys too as I discover new varieties on offer or old favourites back on availability lists. I'll feature some of the 'new' items in the **PLANT OF THE WEEK** section for the next few weeks~ to whet your appetite for what's coming next spring!

**PLANT OF THE WEEK:** Hydrangea paniculata 'La Vasterival' (Great Star)



Having read about 'Great Star' in trade magazines, I'm excited that this new variety is finally available. Panicle hydrangeas are excellent garden performers because of their exceptionally long bloom period (mid-summer through fall) and ease of care. What sets 'Great Star' apart from the others is its large starry blooms with individual florets up to 10cm in diameter. Plants typically grow 1.5m- 2m tall/wide and are hardy to Zone 3.
